Use diverse content from different sources

Use at least two sources from different backgrounds (race, gender, etc.) and formats (research, videos, interviews, etc.).

Create an accessible classroom

Use POUR principles and go above and beyond web accessibility compliance standards such as Section 508, WCAG, and ADA.

4

Truly connect with your students

Use emotional intelligence, inclusive language, and open dialogue to build trust and communication with students.

5

Provide accommodations

Whether it's extra time on exams or bathroom breaks and integrating with assistive devices, accommodations are crucial.
